  - SAB Application is now available! Please consider sharing your skills and talents with us by serving on the SAB for the 2021-2022 school year. The role of the board is to provide counsel and advice to the pastor and principal regarding: Mission Effectiveness, Member Development, Financial and Physical Resources, Institutional Advancement including: Communication, Marketing, Recruitment/Enrollment/Retention, Development and Creation of the school's long-range strategic plan. The minimum time commitment is about 2-3 hours per month including a monthly meeting and follow-up committee work. 
