- This year <u>we will continue to have Wednesday 1:00 dismissals</u> on: September 28th, October 26th,

- Our **staggered arrival times** will continue this year in order to ease the morning traffic flow. Students with the last name beginning with letters A-L should arrive at 7:45 a.m. and students with the last name beginning with letters M-Z should arrive at 7:50. Students will be considered late at 7:55.
- We are thrilled to welcome 45 new families to SJF!
- We opened up a 5^h pre-school room and this year our youngest Falcons will be separated into 3 and 4-year-old classes.
- This year Spanish will be taught weekly in grades kindergarten 8th.

The first payment, which consists of all of the school fees and the first month of tuition will be deducted on August 15th, 2022.
