#### **Important Announcements**

- HoHoHo! FSA Santa Visit Payment is due to the School Office no later than December 8<sup>th</sup>! We can accept cash or check. Please make checks out to St. John Fisher FSA. If you are not paid in full, your spot will be open to someone else. We cannot make any exceptions! Thank you to the families who have already submitted payment!
- The SJF Holiday Grand Raffle Drawing will be live-streamed on theSJF Facebook Page on December 6<sup>th</sup> after the 11:00 mass. Thank you for your incredible support!
- MANNA UPDATE: All school families *will receive* an individual report *next week* in your oldest child's folder outlining your school earnings and tuition credit so far this year. Please review the letter in detail and email <u>sifmanna@gmail.com</u> if you have any questions. Some families have reached the \$300 school earnings requirement already! Thank you! The Manna program is the school's single largest regular fundraising effort without any cost to you. We appreciate increased engagement in recent months resulting in almost 60% of school families registered; however, we are significantly behind the revenue goal we set to help balance the school's operating budget. Any shortage to the minimum \$300 required Manna contribution will be billed to the school family and due by May 15<sup>th</sup>. If a family achieves the \$300 in earnings for the school, it will simultaneously accrue a \$450 tuition credit. WinWin! See <u>Manna Website</u> for additional info on how to get started.

- The Archdiocese Parent Survey results were shared with schools this past week. Based on the data, just over 70% of SJF families are supportive of learning in-person until Christmas Break; similarly, 92% of SJF families have a high satisfaction and comfort level with in-person learning as well as with our COVID health and safety procedures. Thank you for taking the time to complete the survey.
- **Christmas Break** is right around the corner. To clarify, we are scheduled to be learning in-person on December 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> with an 11:30 dismissal on the 22<sup>nd</sup>. Remote learning begins on Wednesday, January 6<sup>th</sup>. More detail regarding our remote learning schedule will be shared with you in the coming weeks.

#### **COVID Reminders**

- Here are answers to some of our most frequently asked questions:
  - If a student becomes ill at school and has 1 or more <u>COVID symptoms</u>, the student and his/her siblings will be sent home. The School Office will send an e-mail to parents communicating that in order for their family to return back to school, parents must share documentation of a negative COVID test result or a doctor's note indicating that the diagnosis is not COVID related.
  - When a student is absent due to an illness, the School Office will e-mail the parents:
    - If the symptom(s) persists for more than 24 hours, the School Office will send an e-mail to parents communicating that in order for their family to return back to school, parents must share documentation of a negative COVID test result or a doctor's note indicating that the diagnosis is not COVID related.
    - Homework cannot be sent home with neighbors or friends, but CAN BE SENT HOME WITH SIBLINGS. Please connect with your students' teacher(s) to coordinate missing work.
    - When picking up your child early from school for whatever reason, parents are expected to wait outside the main office doors.
- If your child's classroom has to quarantine, you only need to quarantine his/her siblings if he/she is showing symptoms of COVID-19. In an effort to keep everyone safe and protect our school community at large, *please communicate with us any documentation you receive from your doctor regarding your child's symptoms/illness*. In order to keep everyone safe, we must always make cautious decisions with the wellbeing of those around us at heart. Thank you for working with us!
- Please partner with us and keep your children safe while outside of school. If we all follow this guidance, we will have a greater chance of keeping our doors open. While your child is not in school, please remind him/her to wear a mask, keep his/her distance, wash and sanitize his/her hands, and stay home if he/she is sick.
- This year you need to reserve your spot for Extended Day Care. Due to the new Covid Safety Guidance, we can only serve 50 students at a time. Here is the form to reserve your spot.



# Bring Light to Dark Times

Did you know that the **Invest in Kids Act** helps children from low-income households in Illinois access scholarships that cover up to 100 percent of a Catholic school's tuition? Thousands of students are gaining knowledge and building on their faith in Archdiocese of Chicago Catholic Schools thanks to this program. Your support during these challenging times would help educate the next generation in Catholic students while building on a brighter future for all.

#### What is a tax credit scholarship?

Tax Credit Scholarships cover up to 100 percent of tuition and fees for the 2021/22 school year. Students from low-income households can qualify for tax credit scholarships if their family income is less than \$72,900. More than 9,000 students qualified for a scholarship last year and 6,300 were left waiting without one.

#### **Cut tax liability**

Individuals and corporations may receive a credit for their Illinois state taxes equal to 75 percent of donation.

#### **Triple your impact**

Donate to a school or all archdiocese schools between Dec. 1 and Feb. 28, 2021, and, thanks to a few generous donors, your donation will be matched and maximized threefold! Limitations apply.

#### **HOW IT WORKS**

We use \$10K in this example, but any amount is needed.

#### **DONATE \$10,000**

After following the step-bystep guide, a taxpayer can donate \$10,000 to Empower Illinois, the Scholarship Granting Organization working with the Archdiocese. Designate the archdiocese's Catholic schools or a specific group of schools as beneficiary.

#### TAX REWARD CAN EQUAL \$7,500

You are eligible to claim a \$7,500 tax credit on your state taxes -75 percent of your gift! This has the potential to eliminate your 2020 tax liability.

## Invest in kids now: 3 easy steps

This **helpful guide from Empower Illinois** will walk you through the process of obtaining a donor account. You will need the primary taxpayer's SSN and one of the following: IL Driver's License #, Il State ID #, or Adjusted Gross Income from the prior year's return.

#### 2 **RESERVE**

Reserve your tax credit with the Illinois Department of Revenue (IDOR). Refer to this list of **eligible schools** to determine where your school of choice is located and designate Empower Illinois as your Scholarship Granting Organization. You will receive your Contribution Authorization Certificate (CAC) via email. Once you have your CAC, you are ready to donate.

#### **3 DONATE**

Once you receive confirmation of your tax credit and your CAC from IDOR, you have up to 60 days to donate to Empower Illinois. For more help, refer to page 7 of this **step-by-step guide**.
