HOW DOES MANNA WORK?

- 1. You buy Manna gift cards at face value and shop with them. Manna is available for hundreds of local and non-local stores and restaurants – even airlines and Visa cards are available! Great for Christmas gifts and great for your usual shopping!
- 2. The store rebates a percentage of the card value to SJF. 40% of that rebate goes toward SJF operational expenses.
- 3. School families get a tuition credit equal to 60% of the store rebate. Non-school families can donate their credit to a school family (at SJF or any school or university) or to the general SJF school.
